

THE TRAVELING WORKSHOP CONSISTS IN THEMATIC FIELD-TRIP to the Holocaust sites, comprising:

a selection of concentration and extermination CAMPS, GHETTOS, MUSEUMS, and MEMORIALS;

Documentary film/ Feature FILM PROJECTIONS from the selected biography – on road documentation;

open DISCUSSIONS at the Holocaust sites (in site analysis: observation & comments) & Round table SEMINAR DISCUSSIONS in Bucharest;

thematic lecture & discussions on Daniel Libeskind, Peter Eisenman, Peter Zumthor, Juhani Pallasmaa THEORICAL approach.

Objectives/ visits to:

the concentration and extermination camps: Auschwitz-Birkenau, Majdanek, Sachsenhausen.

the remains of the Holocaust Ghettos in: Krakow, Warsaw, Berlin.

the main Holocaust Museums in Berlin & Warsaw with insight documentation and cinematographic projections: Polish Museum Warsaw, Jewish Museum Berlin, Topography of Terror Documentation Center – Berlin; (optional in Berlin: Memorial Visitors Center / Berlin Wall history, Tchoban Foundation Museum for Architectural Drawing/ exhibition: Alexander Brodsky. Works.)

selected memorials: Berlin: Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe, Gleis 17 Memorial, Bebelplatz - site of the Burning of Books, Vienna: Judenplatz Holocaust Memorial, Budapest: Shoes on the Danube Bank (optional: Bebelplatz - site of the Burning of Books)
